Day of Tournament:

1. Pay by Cash or Check. If Fee is Being Donated to a RivALZ Player, Please Make a Note Upon Check-In

Rules:

1. Volleyball check-in is from 7:30am-8:15am
2. Volleyball captain's rules meeting is from 8:15am-8:25am
3. First games warm-ups start at 8:25am. First games start at 8:30am.
4. Standard sand volleyball rules apply.
5. All teams will be allowed a 5-minute warm-up before each game starts.
6. To determine serve, side or receive, assigned ref will have the captains do rock, paper, scissors. Winner picks serve, side or receive. If side is not picked, the other team has the option to pick their side to start.
7. Number of males may not double the number of females on the court.
8. A minimum of four players must be on the court to start the game and throughout regulation
 1. The only exception is in the event of an injury. The team may finish with three.
9. If a team has more than six players, or if a player rotates in late, players must rotate in the back middle after the server.
10. Rally scoring.
11. Let serves are allowed.
12. Call foot faults on serve
13. Rotate serve on every side out
14. You may set a serve - no spiking/blocking a serve.
15. There is no 'boy'/'girl' rule on who needs to touch the ball before sending it over the net.
16. Stay out of the net. No lifts. Call obvious doubles (take the wind into consideration).
17. No foot digs
18. If the ball hits the surrounding nets, the referee stand, or the volleyball post, the play is dead.
19. Back row attacks are allowed if the player takes off from the back-row.
20. If the ref misses a call, and you are aware of it, call it on yourself please.
21. Pool play will consist of two games best to 21, win by two, cap is 25. Do not play a third even in the result of a tie.
22. Tournament is best of three games to 21, win by two, cap at 25. Third game will not be played one team wins the first two.
23. Teams will ref when they are not playing. Ref assignments will be listed for Pool Play. If you have your own whistle, bring it otherwise there will be some available.
24. Ref assignments for the Tournament will be assigned when the bracket comes out. Typically, the losing team will ref the next game on their court.
25. Tournament Bracket will be available at Halftime of the RivALZ Flag Football Game.
26. Play fair, play honest, have fun!

Pool Play Format:

1. Pool Play will run from 8:30am-11:30am
2. Three pools: A on Court 1, B on Court 2, and C on Court 3. Four teams per pool.
3. Teams will play two games to 21 against every team in their pool. Win by two, cap is at 25.
4. Ref assignments will be listed on each team's Pool Play schedule. Teams will only ref their pool.
5. Number of wins vs. losses will determine the seed placement for the tournament. In the event of a tie between teams, the score of each pool play game will be taken into consideration when determining seed placement for tournament.

Tournament Format:

1. Tournament will run from approximately 1:00pm-5:30pm -
 1. Starts at the conclusion of the RivALZ Flag Football Game and runs until all games are played.
2. Every team is guaranteed to make the tournament.
3. Double Elimination during Tournament
4. Bracket and Ref assignments will be posted at halftime of the RivALZ Flag Football Game.
5. Games will be best of three games to 21, win by 2, cap at 25. Third game will not be played if one team wins the first two.
6. If the third game is played, it will be played to 21, win by 2, cap at 25. Teams will swap the sides of the court when the first team gets to 10 unless both teams agree not to before the start of the game.
7. The overall first, second, third, and fourth place teams in Pool Play will have a first-round bye. If any of these teams lose in the second round of tournament play, they will move on to the Loser's Bracket (hence, the double-elimination rule).
8. During the first round of tournament play, the winner moves on in the Winner's Bracket. If your team then loses in the second round, you are eliminated.
9. Losing teams of the first-round games in the tournament move on to the Loser's Bracket. Once a team loses in the Loser's Bracket, they are eliminated.
10. If your team loses a game during tournament, (whether you're still in or not) you will have to ref the next game on the court you just played on unless you find a replacement.
11. Rounds 1 and 2 of the Winner's Bracket will use all three courts.
12. Round 3 of the Winner's Bracket will use Court 1 - the final four will play back to back on Court 1.
13. Rounds 3 & 4 of the Loser's Bracket will use Courts 1 & 2
14. The Third Place Match will take place on Court 1 immediately after the last game of Round 3 (final four) in the Winner's Bracket - the two losing teams will play each other for third place
15. The Final will take place on Court 1 immediately after the Third Place Match to play for first and second place.
16. The Consolation Championship for Fourth Place will take place on Court 2 during the Final.
