- 2- 20-minute halves running clock unless for injury, 5-minute warm up, and 5-minute half time.
- KEVA instructors will be the officials and coaches along with volunteers.
- Every 5 minutes the teams will substitution all players on the court and the 5 substitutes will enter into the game.
- Coaches will help with substitutions and explaining gameplay and fouls.
- Rims will be set to 8 feet.
- No score will be kept.
- Basketball size will be 27.5
- No team will have more than 10 players on their roster. They will play 5 on 5.
- The away team will start with the ball and the home team will start with the ball at the beginning of the second half.
- No fouls will be recorded. When a foul does happen, the fouled team will inbound on the closes sideline. The official will explain to both teams why that was a foul.
- There will be no free throws.
- Defense can only be played when the team with possession of the ball goes past the opponents 3-point line
- One-one defense only. No double teaming, zone defense, and switching players.
- No stealing the ball when a player has possession of it. The only time a player can take the ball is when they are passing it.

- 2- 20-minute halves running clock unless for injury, 5-minute warm up, and 5-minute half time.
- KEVA instructors will be the officials and the coach's volunteer.
- Every 5 minutes teams will substitution all players on the court and the 5 substitutes will enter into the game.
- Coaches will help with substitutions and explaining gameplay and fouls.
- Rims will be set to 9 feet and can come down to 8 feet.
- No score will be kept.
- Basketball size will be 27.5
- No team will have more than 10 players on their roster. They will play 5 on 5.
- The away team will start with the ball and the home team will start with the ball at the beginning of the second half.
- No fouls will be recorded. When a foul does happen, the fouled team will inbound on the closes sideline. The official will explain to both teams why that was a foul.
- There will be no free throws.
- Defense can only be played when the team with possession of the ball goes past the three-point line.
- One on one defense only. No double teaming, zone defense, and switching players.
- No stealing the ball when a player has possession of it during the first half. The only time a player can take the ball is when they are passing it. Stealing the ball will be allowed during the second half.

KEVA SPORTS CENTER BASKETBALL RULES 3rd Grade

- 2- 20-minute halves running clock unless for injury, 5-minute warm up, and 5-minute half time.
- Keva instructors will be the officials and the coach's volunteer.
- Every 5 minutes teams will substitution all players on the court and the 5 substitutes will enter into the game.
- Coaches will help with substitutions and explaining gameplay and fouls.
- Rims will be set to 9 feet and can be lowered to 8 feet.
- Score will be kept. When a team has more than a 20-point lead score will stop being kept.
- Every half both teams will have 2 timeouts 30 second timeouts. The clock will still run when a team has called a timeout.
- Basketball size will be 28.5
- No team will have more than 10 players on their roster. They will play 5 on 5.
- Both halves will start by a jump ball.
- No fouls will be recorded. When a foul does happen, the fouled team will inbound on the closes sideline. The official will explain to both teams why that was a foul.
- Free throws will happen when a player is fouled in the act of shooting.
- Defense can only be played when the team with possession of the ball goes past the three-point line.
- One on One defense only. No double teaming, zone defense, and switching players.
